US 51 runs south past Illinois State University, Illinois Wesleyan University and into Downtown Bloomington. Raab Road, the crossroad just north of the property runs west to Heartland Community College and continues on to Rivian Automotive. This immediate area has a lot of commercial development and demand with continued growth in jobs and population.

Bloomington-Normal is a desirable market with a diversified economy. Bloomington is the county seat of McLean County, IL and the world headquarters to State Farm Insurance (14,500 employees) and Country Financial (2,025 employees), Other major employers that provide industry diversification, Illinois State University (3,940 employees), Rivian Automotive (7,500 employees), and OSF Healthcare (1,286 employees), others include Nussbaum Transportation, Beer Nuts Brand Snacks, and McLean County is one of the most productive agricultural areas in the nation, which attracted Brandt Industries to the community.

The twin cities are serviced by four major railroad lines and Amtrak, as well as air transportation at the Central Illinois Regional Airport, which services commuter, corporate, and private aircraft.
